








## Medication at School

Medication is given at school only when absolutely necessary for adequate treatment for a child.

1. If your child needs to take any medication during the school day, bring a completed Medication at School form (below), along with your child's medication, to the **HEALTH OFFICE** at school.

\*After we receive this from you, then we are able to administer your child's medication at school.

2. If your child has asthma, your child **IS** allowed to carry their inhaler with them, if the Medication at School form (below), signed by you and your physician, indicates that this is appropriate.

3. If your child needs to take medication at school for more than one school year, a new Medication at School form (below) must be completed and submitted **EACH YEAR**, at the beginning of the school year.
