

This test was created with teacher input to...</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Measure how well your child has mastered the skills and content in Mathematics and English language arts at his or her grade level. ◆ Align with the instruction that takes place in the classroom every day. ◆ Match the learning goals of each grade level. ◆ Assess critical thinking, analytical writing, and problem solving skills, which are needed for success in college and a 21st century career. <p>The test has different kinds of questions, including traditional multiple-choice questions as well as ones that require students to explain their answers, show their work, and compose essays.</p> <p>The results from this test aren't meant to tell the whole story. Your child's scores are meant to be one of several ways for you and your child's teacher to see how your student is progressing in school. Test scores, along with student report cards and teacher's observations of your child's performance in the classroom, are used together to form a complete picture of your child's achievement.</p> <p>At Valley Oak Elementary, our goal is for all students to achieve their fullest potential.
