To register a new student, you will need the following documentation. <b>An official birth certificate</b> (State/County issued) or US Passport. <b>Proof of residency:</b> Such as a gas or electric bill, rental agreement or escrow papers within 45 days of closing; Recent Property Tax Payment receipt, Recent Pay Check Stub, Voter Registration Card or A certified copy of the Voter Registration Application Form. <b>Updated Immunization Information.</b> Please give us a call if you have any questions @ 327-8200.</p>	
<th data-bbox="77 1131 803 1176">Kastner Community Funded Bus</th> <p data-bbox="77 1176 803 1434"><b>The VO/Liberty/Kastner Community Funded Bus will no longer be available starting in the 2018-2019 school year.</b> Transportation costs have increased tremendously, costing families approximately \$350 a school year. Each year, the demand of riders does not fill to max capacity of the bus, causing additional funds to be requested from families. The CFB is a self-funded program and the full funding is technically required to be paid outright prior to the first day of school. With this understanding, discrepancies such as dropped riders, insufficient funds, and not being able to meet max capacity, makes it difficult to collect funding in advance. We are sorry for the inconvenience and hope that each family will have plenty of time to figure out transportation for this next school year.
