## Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment forms for the 2022-2023 school year may be picked up and/or submitted in the Valley Oak office until Oct. 28, 2021. Student Services and School Attendance office will accept applications until Nov. 1, 2021. Students currently on Intra-district transfers are required to apply for an Open Enrollment to continue enrollment in their current school of choice. Open Enrollment transfers are only available to students who live within the Clovis Unified boundaries and are entering the 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. \*No late applications will be accepted.

## Arrival Times and Dismissal Times

Supervision begins at **7:55AM** for students in grades 1-6 therefore; students who do not ride the bus and those who are not enrolled in Campus Club **are not to be on campus before 7:55AM**. For the safety and well-being of your student, please adhere to this policy. Dismissal time for grades 1-6 is 3:15PM for a regular school day and 1:45PM for Wednesday Early Dismissal. All students must go directly home at the end of each school day unless they are involved in after school activities. Younger siblings of athletes may not attend practice without adult supervision.
