By completing the no cost meal eligibility forms, you may receive meals for your family and also help provide important intervention and support resources for our school. Completing this form helps our school access much-needed state funds for academic and intervention support for students. You may access the application via parent connect or pick up a paper application in the main office.

- If your family qualified to receive free or reduced price meals last school year, time is running out for you to complete a new application for the 2018-19 school year.
- If you do not complete a new application before the upcoming deadline, your child's meal eligibility will expire, and they will no longer be able to receive no cost meals at school.
- Thank you for helping us ensure every Valley Oak student eligible for free or reduced price meals continues to be served this year.

Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment forms for the 2019-2020 school year may be picked up and/or submitted in the Valley Oak office or at the Student Services and School Attendance office until November 1, 2018. **Students currently on Intra-district transfers are required to apply for Open Enrollment to continue enrollment in their current school of choice.**

Intra-district transfers are valid for only 1 year only and may not be renewed due to Board Policy #2209. Open Enrollment applications are available for Clovis Unified residents only. If you have recently moved out of the Valley Oak boundary area, you must apply for an Intra-district transfer to remain at Valley Oak for the remainder of the year.
