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## Online Volunteer Application

In an effort to continue to ensure student safety and best practices with respect to volunteers, any person that volunteers more than 8 hours during the school year or wishes to be a chaperone on the 6th grade trip to Sierra Outdoor School, will need to complete the Volunteer Application Form using the online link on the Valley Oak website <https://valleyoak.cusd.com/>

It is most efficient if you have your TB documentation on hand when you complete this process. If you volunteered during the 2018-19 school year and do not have a copy of your TB clearance documentation, we may have a copy on file we can provide you with. Your TB clearance and TB Risk Assessment are valid for 4 years. If you should need this copy, please see our school office. Once you have completed your application and uploaded your documents, your application will be put in the que for approval through our Raptor Visitor/Volunteer system.

If you submit the Volunteer Application without proof of your TB clearance, your volunteer approval will be pending until the proper TB clearance is provided to the office.

Please remember to check in at the front office to receive a badge anytime you are visiting or volunteering on our campus. With your help, we will ensure that all safety measures are in place as we begin the 2019-2020 school year.

## Arrival and Dismissal Times

Supervision begins at 7:55am for students in grades 1-6 therefore; students who do not ride the bus and those who are not enrolled in Campus Club are not to be on campus before 7:55am. For the safety and well-being of your student, please adhere to this policy. Dismissal time for grades 1-6 is 3:15pm for a regular school day and 1:45pm for Wednesday Early Dismissal. All students must go directly home at the end of each school day unless they are involved in after school activities.

## Permission Click

This year our school will be using Permission Click for athletic permission slips. It is a very easy process that involves completing all the necessary forms on-line. The email link has been sent to all 4-6 grade parents. This information MUST be completed prior to your student being involved in athletics. If you have not received the link, please contact the main office or refer to the Valley Oak website.

## Medication at school

If your child needs to take any medication during the school day, bring a completed Medication at School form (available in school office and on our school website), along with your child's medication, to the Valley Oak health office. After this form is received, the health office can then administer your child's medication at school.

If your child needs to take medication at school for more than one school year, a new Medication at School form must be completed and submitted each school year, at the beginning of the school year.

Please remember that once the bell rings at 8:25am, all lunches go directly to the cart outside the main office. Our wonderful Campus Monitors will make sure it gets to your child.

All other items must be brought to the office. This is a CUSD policy.
