Principal's Message

Dear Wildcat Families.

We received another dreaded Friday email this past week, reiterating there would not be a return of new students to campus at this time. There was not another date set other than our county would need to be at or under 25 cases per 100,000 before we could allow those not previously on campus to come in-person. Just another announcement that leads us to the need of having the character strength of perseverance.

The great majority of our students are continuing to have excellent daily attendance and active participation. I just wanted to reiterate that we our district is operating under State Bill 98. One of the most important factors in keeping our students engaged in their learning is <u>daily live interaction</u> with certificated employees and peers for purposes of instruction, progress monitoring, and maintaining school connectedness. (Ed. Code, § 43503(b).)

As a school we are required to "document daily participation for each pupil on each school day, in whole or in part, for which distance learning is provided." Daily participation is defined to include: (1) evidence of participation in online activities (including completing assignments and assessments) or (2) contact between the teacher and the pupil or parent/guardian. Students not engaged in daily participation must be marked absent.

Again, I know the entire situation that has been upon us this year has been difficult. We want our students to continue to grow and thrive. As always, communicate with your child's teacher regarding any issues your child may be having.
