## A Message From The Nurse

Keeping kids healthy all year long is very important to us. Please don't send your child to school if he or she is running a fever of **100 degrees or higher** and has one or more of the following symptoms: a cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, vomiting or diarrhea, extreme fatigue, or a rash.

Before sending your child back to school after an illness, make sure he or she is fever-free (without the use of a fever reducer, like Tylenol) for **24 hours**. Students who arrive at school with illness symptoms like those mentioned above will be sent home to recover.

## Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment forms for the 2019-2020 school year may be picked up and/or submitted in the Valley Oak office by Oct. 26, 2018. Student Services and School Attendance office will accept applications until November 1, 2018. **Students currently on Intra-district transfers are required to apply for an Open Enrollment to continue enrollment in their current school of choice.** Open Enrollment transfers are only available to students who live within the Clovis Unified boundaries and are entering the 1st-12th grade.
