If you want your student to attend a different Clovis Unified School than the one aligned to your home, or if your student is CURRENTLY on an Intra-District Transfer to another Clovis Unified School other than the one aligned to your home. Once approved, Open Enrollment transfers are valid through 12th grade with some conditions. Open Enrollment forms for the 2021-2022 school year may be picked up and/or submitted in the Valley Oak office by Oct. 28, 2020. You can also go online to cusd.com and search for Open Enrollment, click on the option "Download the Open Enrollment Transfer Application", fill it out and email it to sssa@cusd.com before 4:00PM on Friday Oct. 30 th . This transfer is not available to those families that live outside of Clovis Unified School District boundaries. *Students currently on Intra-District transfers are required to apply for an Open Enrollment to continue enrollment in their current school of choice. *No late applications will be accepted.
